Senate District 31 candidate Jeremy Miller files 2010 Campaign Finance Report
Friends for Miller reports over \$57,000 raised in 2010

Winona, Minn.- The campaign of Jeremy Miller, endorsed Republican candidate for Minnesota's District 31 State Senate seat, recently filed its 2010 campaign finance report, which included more than \$57,000 in receipts in 2010, including \$41,260 of individual contributions and the State of Minnesota's \$8,408 public subsidy payment.

"We are extremely pleased with the strong support that we have received from the people of Southeastern Minnesota and beyond," said Jeremy Miller. "The over 400 individual contributions that we received in 2010 allows us to remain financially competitive with Senator Ropes, despite the fact that over 25% of her contributions were from lobbyists and special interest groups."

In the category of contributions making up less than \$250, Friends for Miller raised over \$31,000, approximately 50% more than Senator Ropes.

"We built strong momentum from a wide ranging base of contributors and volunteers. We've received contributions from people of all walks of life, including farmers, teachers, nurses, small business owners, students, veterans, and families," Miller said. "We are proud to have support from Democrats, Republicans, and Independents."

"This fundraising report clearly proves that hard work pays off," Miller said. "My wife Janel and I have knocked on over 15,000 doors throughout Senate District 31, and people share the same concerns. They are simply fed-up, frustrated, and extremely worried about the direction government is taking them. They have made it clear that they are looking for a fresh perspective and new leadership."

Miller's focus is to move Minnesota forward by listening and working together with the people, reducing wasteful government spending, and creating more jobs in the State of Minnesota.

"I am thankful for the gifts of time, talent, and monetary contributions donated to our campaign from people across Southeastern Minnesota," said Miller.
